

CONGREGATION TIFERES YISROEL  
HIGH HOLIDAY CHILD CARE  
(Camp Yom Tov)

Once again, Tiferes Yisroel will offer child care for Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur for infants and children up to 8 years old. We will also continue the junior counselor program for children ages 8-11. To ensure the safety and well being of our children, as well as the beautiful davening in our shul, we strongly suggest that all children under the age of eight be enrolled in Camp Yom Tov. Parents **MUST** supervise their children at all times if they are not enrolled in child care.

The junior counselors do have certain responsibilities such as assisting the child care staff with looking after the younger children and helping to set up and clean up as needed. Junior counselors will be given special name badges and will be allowed to check themselves in and out of Camp Yom Tov.

Although there will be toys and games at the shul, your child may want to bring some of his/her own special toys. Please send a dairy or pareve lunch and appropriate outdoor clothing, as well as any other needed items (i.e. a blanket and/or diaper bag). Be sure to mark all personal items clearly with your child's name. Please remind your children to treat the shul property with respect at all times.

**Please do not send any peanut or tree nut products in your child's lunch.**

Please inform the staff of any behavioral or special physical needs of your child, especially allergies. The staff will make every effort to ensure that children stay in Camp Yom Tov. However, if a child refuses to stay, Camp Yom Tov staff will inform the parents who then take full responsibility for the supervision of their child. Obviously, any children who become ill or are in

need of medication or first aid need to be tended to by their parents or a designated older sibling.

The total number of campers and counselors registered and paid for by Sunday, August 22, 2010 will determine the number of paid child care providers. A late fee of \$10 will be charged for any enrollments after this date. All checks should be made payable to Congregation Tiferes Yisroel and mailed to 6201 Park Heights Avenue, Baltimore, MD 21215.

The registration fee just barely covers the salaries of the childcare staff and the purchase of snacks for the children. THERE IS NO PROFIT TO THE SHUL.

### **Camp Yom Tov Hours**

Rosh Hashanah: 9:30 am to 2:00 pm

Kol Nidrei: 6:50 pm to 9:30 pm

Yom Kippur day: 9:30 am to 2:30 pm

Neilah: 6:15 pm to 8:30 pm

The total cost for all days of Camp Yom Tov is \$60 for one camper, \$70 for two, and \$80 for 3 or more children. The registration fee for junior counselors (ages 8-11) is \$20 per child for any or all of the days. This \$20 does count toward the family maximum.

An amount of \$8 per hour per child must be paid for any part time arrangement.

PLEASE speak with your children and remind them of the Camp Yom Tov rules:

- 1) Campers and counselors must listen to the staff.
- 2) To keep everyone safe, children must stay in the designated areas.
- 3) Parents and siblings must communicate with the staff before leaving a child in camp or removing a child from camp.

Each family who enrolls a child into Camp Yom Tov is required to donate one hour of time for general assistance to the staff. Upon registration you will be called to arrange your time. The schedule will be posted by the entrance to the women's section.

Please indicate your preferred time on the registration form. Options are: Rosh Hashana 1<sup>st</sup> day or 2<sup>nd</sup> day 9:30-10:30, 10:30-11:30, 11:30-12:30, 12:30-1:30, Kol Nidrei 7:00-8:00, 8:00-9:00, Yom Kippur Day 9:30-10:30, 10:30-11:30, 11:30-12:30, 12:30-1:30, 1:30-2:30, Ne'ilah 6:15-7:15, 7:15-8:15
